

# What Do I Need for Graduation?



- **English: 4 credits**
- **Math: 4 credits**, including Algebra I, II, Geometry and a fourth higher level math course (Students must be enrolled in a mathematics course each school year.)
- **Science: 3 credits**, including Biology, Chemistry or Physics, and a third course (Physical Science, Biology II, Anatomy and Physiology, etc.)
- **Social Studies: 3.5 credits** (World History, U.S. History, Government, ½ credit in Economics)
- **Physical Education and Wellness: 1.5 credits**
- **Personal Finance: 0.5 credit**
- **Foreign Language: 2 credits** (Spanish, French or Latin)
- **Fine Arts: 1 credit**
- **Computers: One credit** of a computer course (Computer Applications, Computer Science Foundations, etc.)
- **Program of Study (Non CTE): 3 credits** – Students choose from:
  - Math and Science
  - Career and Technical Education (many options here—see reverse)
  - Fine Arts (theater, music, visual art)
  - Humanities (social studies, English or foreign language)
  - JROTC

*These classes represent the minimum requirements for graduation in the state of Tennessee. Blount County Schools requires a total of 28 credits.*
